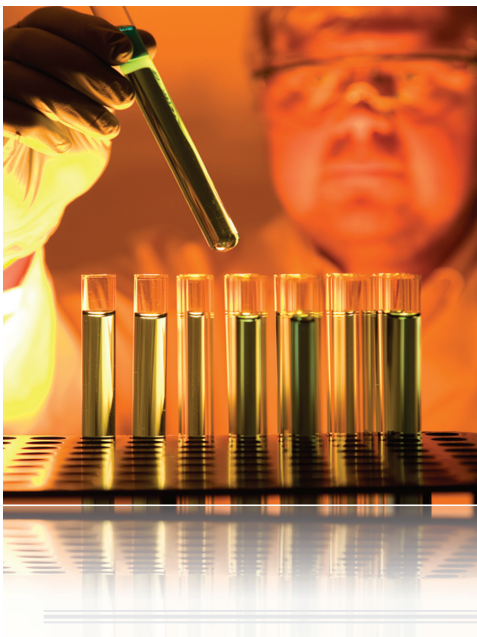

Designed for the research needs of the post-college professional, this database provides full text for more than 3,350 journals—including more than 3,000 peer-reviewed journals—as well as indexing and abstracting for more than 8,200 journals. 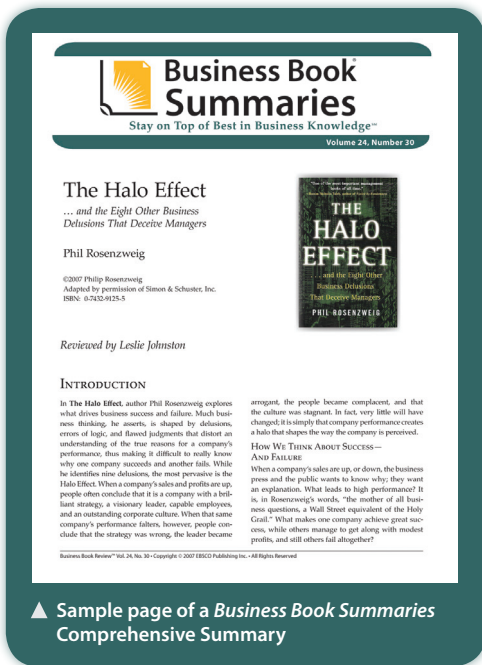
